Respond to God's _____.

*“Again, **it** will be like a man going on a **journey**, who called his **servants** and **entrusted** his wealth to them. 15 To one he gave five bags of gold, to another two bags, and to another one bag, each according to his **ability**. Then he went on his journey. Matthew 25:14-15*

*1 Cor. 3:8 The one who plants and the one who waters have **one purpose**, and they will each be rewarded according to their own labor.*

James 1:17, “Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.”

*The man who had received five bags of gold went at once and put his money to work and **gained** five bags more. 17 So also, the one with two bags of gold **gained** two more. Matthew 25:16-17*

But the man who had received one bag went off, dug a hole in the ground and hid his master's money. Mt. 25:18

*“Then the man who had received one bag of gold came. ‘Master,’ he said, ‘I knew that you are a **hard** man, harvesting where you have not sown and*

*gathering where you have not scattered seed. 25 So I was **afraid** and went out and hid your gold in the ground. See, here is what belongs to you.’ Mt. 25:24-25*
